PCS PTF Committees Overview



Below are the standing committees within the PTF overview. The presiding officer is listed beside the committee. Budgets have not been established. Each committee must have a minimum of three members, but not more than seven, unless the executive board determines the need for additional members. To allow each PTF member to have an opportunity to serve, a member may only serve on two committees at a time, without express prior approval of the executive board.

- 1. Community Outreach President
 - To allow the surrounding area to become aware of all the school's offerings through community events as a vendor, parade participants, and coordinate parent fellowship opportunities.
- 2. Fundraising President
 - To raise general PTF funds which will be presented in the budget.
- 3. Safety Vice President
 - To address safety concerns and prioritize safety improvements.
- 4. Alumni Vice President
 - To stay connected to fellow alumna and the school.
- 5. Welcoming New Families Secretary
 - To establish a connection for new families enrolling in PCS.
- 6. Field day Secretary
 - To coordinate the structure of field day.
- 7. Teacher Appreciation Treasurer
 - To show support and appreciate for the educators with monthly breakfast or lunch planning and assist with teachers' wish list items.
